AFFIDAVIT OF MESHELLE LITTELL

The undersigned, Meshelle Littell, being first duly sworn, hereby states as follows:

1. I, Meshelle Littell, am over the age of 18, am of sound mind, and have personal knowledge of the matters set forth in this affidavit.

2. Beginning in approximately January 1992, I worked at 2503 Marina Drive (formerly 53381 Marina Drive), Elkhart, Indiana (the "Seat Shop") for Dygert Seating Inc. ("Dygert Seating") until approximately two weeks before Flexsteel Industries, Inc. ("Flexsteel") took over operations.

3. During my employment at the Seat Shop, I worked in the stuffing and gluing department.

4. I reviewed the Affidavit of Terry Littell signed on March 5, 2012, and agree with the statements made therein.

5. I also remember Dygert Seating employees dumping glue pots and tin cans containing solvent outside.

6. We did this because that is what we were told to do by Dygert Seating management.

7. I specifically remember asking one of my supervisors at Dygert Seating what to do with my excess solvent, and he told me to dump it outside.

8. I remember that there were several types of solvent used by Dygert Seating during the years that I worked there.

9. I specifically remember that trichloroethylene was one of the solvents that we used in connection with cleaning the glue gun equipment.
